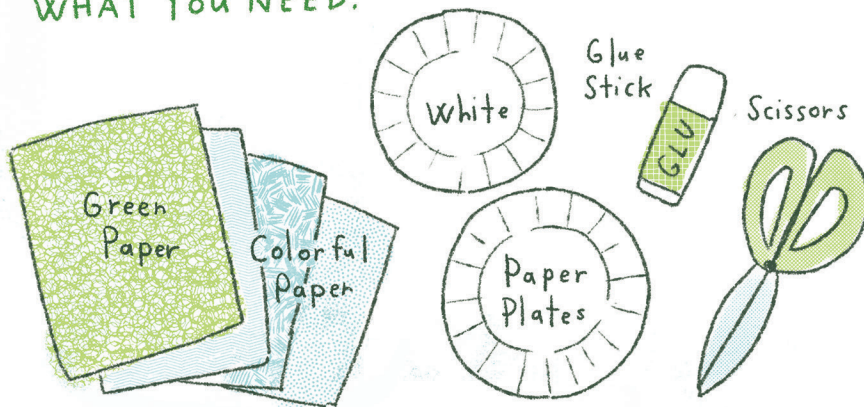
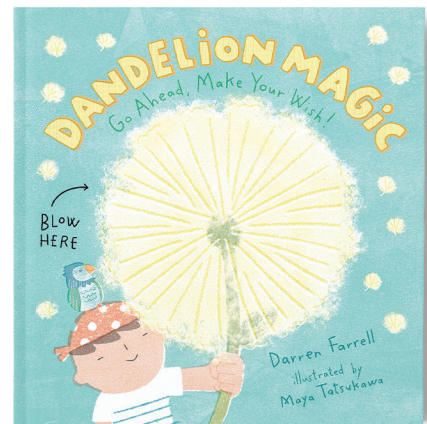


# PAPER PLATE DANDELIONS

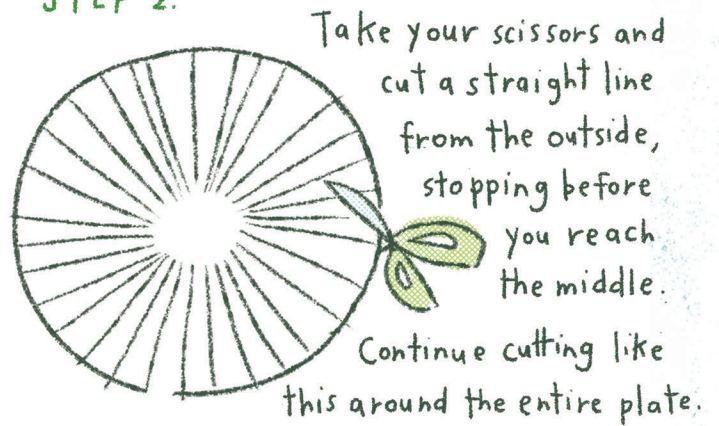
Want to know what to do with the leftovers after you've eaten all the leftovers? Take the extra paper plates and turn them into unlimited wall-wishers! With dandelion art on your wall, you get to make at least one wish each time you pass it.

## STEP 1.



Fold the green paper in half and draw a wiggly dandelion leaf, then use your scissors to cut it out. This will create 2 leaves. Next, unfold the paper and cut a long skinny stem.

## STEP 2.



Take your scissors and cut a straight line from the outside, stopping before you reach the middle. Continue cutting like this around the entire plate.

## STEP 3.



Glue the dandelion plate, leaves, stem, on the colorful paper, and curl the petals on the dandelion plate to make them spring off the page.

If you want a fluffier dandelion, repeat step 2 with a smaller plate and glue it on top of the first plate.

## STEP 4.



Enjoy wishing on this never ending dandelion magic!
